SERMON SUMMARY

Revelation 8:7-13 – Desolation on Earth

Pastor Art returned refreshed from vacation and immediately jumped back into our study of Revelation with a sermon entitled "Desolation of Earth," based on Revelation 8:7-13. After thanking Tim O'Dell and the elders for filling in last week and bringing such a clearcut message, he directed everyone to Matthew 24:3 and 21. The apostles (believers who had actually seen and studied with Jesus) asked Jesus questions about the end times and he gives his reply in verse 21. When you see the phrase "The Day of the Lord," this is not referring to the rapture but the full return of Christ on earth. The most important question anyone can ask themselves is this - "Am I saved?" The Day of the Lord follows after the great tribulation. God will pour out his wrath on a Christ rejecting world. Go to the Word of God for answers to your questions. Not only will you find answers but practical applications of the sermon for your life. Read James 5:16 and Hebrews 10:26. In the book of Exodus, chapters 7 through 9 reveal God's wrath against Egypt as he uses Moses and Aaron to put 9 plagues upon Egypt. This is not the only example of God's wrath turned against the earth. The judgments from today's scripture passage in Revelation are an answered prayer. Read chapter 6 of Revelation. Your prayers matter.

An eighth angel is mentioned in today's scripture passage. In Luke 1:5-25, a priest is sent to the altar of incense. That priest is Zechariah and he has been called to burn incense for God, while others pray and worship in

CALL TO WORSHIP

Read Psalm 141:1-4

WELCOME

During second service, Brenda King came forward to become a member of the church. Please welcome her! the courtyard of the temple. Zechariah and Elizabeth are righteous individuals and have lived to an old age. The Angel Gabriel appears and stands at the right side of the altar of incense, a position of prominence. Incense in heaven mingles with the prayers of the saints. Gabriel announces the birth of John the Baptist.

Back to Revelation, in Revelation 6:9 the tribulation saints are praying that God passes judgment. Then in Revelation 8:5 the angel took the censer and put fire in it and through it to the earth. Read Zephaniah 1:7. In Revelation 8:7, the first trumpet is blown by the angel, fire and hail mixed with blood was hurled to the earth where 1/3 of the trees and grass was immediately burned up. In verse 8, the second trumpet sounded and a burning mountain fell into the sea causing it to turn to blood and 1/3 of the ships and all living things in the sea were destroyed. Read Exodus chapter 7 where God turned the Nile River to blood. We are seeing the destruction of all the things the world worships before or instead of God. In verse 10, the sounding of the trumpet brings a fiery star that crashes to earth and destroys 1/3 of the rivers and natural springs. Read Psalm 147:4-5. Wormwood was the name of this star and it caused the water to be bitter. In verse 12 the 4th angel sounded the trumpet and darkness fell on the earth as 1/3 of the sun, moon and stars were gone. Read Matthew 24:29-31 and Mark 13:24-25. Remember the 9th plague was darkness in Egypt. Verse 13 concludes with an eagle flying and crying out "Woe, woe, woe to the inhabitants of earth." Read Amos 5:18 and Joel 2:2. Life is but a vapor. Read Hebrews 11:8-10. We are to be the light of Christ. Set on a hill for all to see. Living a life that reflects Christ. Praising God for a pastor who brings fresh insight to God's Word for each of his flock to apply to their lives!
