SERMON SUMMARY

Revelation 9 - Hell Released

8/12 - Revelation 8:11, 3, 5 "Prayer Time." Read Revelation 6:11 and Exodus chapter 7-9.

8/13 - None

8/14 - Revelation 8 and Psalm 19:1-2, 7-10 "Is God Trying to Get Your Attention?"

8/15 - Mark 14:66-72 "Godly Relationships." Read Mark 14:27-31.

8/16 - Revelation 9 and Revelation 8:13 "Thoughts." Read Philippians 4:8-9, Romans 8:28 and Hebrews 10:26.

Pastor Art started his sermon entitled "Hell Released Revelation 9" by backing up to the last verse of chapter 8. The main message is don't put off sharing the Good News. Be bold and speak the truth in love. The three trumpets acknowledged in the closing verse of chapter 8 accelerate God's wrath upon a Christ rejecting world. This wrath will not fall upon believers. Read I Thessalonians 5:9. In chapter 9 of Revelation we discover we have no control. The world convinces us that man has control but he does not. God does. Today's scripture passage is Revelation 9:1-12. Supporting these verses is II Peter 3:9. Jesus talked more about hell than anyone else in the Bible. Turn from sin and seek Christ's example. Salvation only comes from Jesus. Jesus went specifically to the cross so that we would not experience hell.

In verse 1, when the angel sounded the trumpet, a superstar fell from heaven. We know him as Satan. But he is described as beautiful and accomplished. For other descriptions and names read Isaiah 14:12, Ezekiel 28:11-17 and Luke 10:18. Demons are fallen angels. Read Luke 8:26-33. When Satan was cast out of heaven, 1/3 of the angels went with him. Some were cast directly into hell - the worst of the worst. It is easy to be deceived by Satan, which is why we rely on Christ for guidance and protection. In this passage, demons are released and directed to torture non-believers but not to kill them. God is the author of life. Evil dwells in darkness. The torment continues for 5 months. The king over the demons

PRAYER

Pastor Art has spent time in both his devotions and Sunday messages emphasizing the importance of prayer in the life of a Christ follower. August presented a number of opportunities to engage in corporate prayer. On Saturday, August 17, fifteen individuals, including a high school student, showed up to prayerwalk the Orrick Schools. The weather was glorious and we prayed God's power down on this school district and prayed to kick Satan to the curb. This was the largest turnout that we have had for this prayer event

Backpacks are loaded with new supplies, lunch boxes are ready to be prepared, and first day of school outfits have been purchased. We are in the throes of the Back- to- School season. It is one full of all kinds of emotions. Prayer is our weapon. It is the most powerful thing that you can do for your child. As the school year begins, here are some scripture prayers for your consideration.

Prayers for the School:

Lord God, the Bible tells us that, " Everyone should be subject to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established." (Romans 13:1) I pray that the kids attending school this year are respectful of their Principals, teachers, and school staff. Let the school be run in an orderly fashion. I ask that the school become a place of encouragement for the teachers and students. Give teachers wisdom as they prepare lessons. I pray that students would embrace teachings that are God-aligning and intelligent. I also pray that any teachings that go against Your word would not take heart in any of the student's minds. Instead, may the light of the gospel be perceived in every subject whether it is math, science, English, or history. You are the Creator of all things. You reign above it all. You can shed light in dark places. I pray for Divine protection for the school campuses and students. According to Zechariah 2:5, "May Jehovah be a wall of fire round about, and the glory in her midst." Lord, protect the local schools and colleges. Be that Wall of fire around the campus and be the fire of the Holy Spirit in the midst. Please raise up godly students, teachers, and administrators that guide and guard the hearts of our children. Help each student to find identity in You and nothing else. Draw the lost to You. Set our schools on fire by the Holy Spirit. Raise up Moms in Prayer Groups in every school so that the lives of students are covered in prayer.

Prayers for Your Child:

God, I pray that my child would be, "Strong in the Lord and in His mighty power. May he/she put on the full armor of God so that he/she can be prepared and take a stand against the devil's schemes. Make him/her aware that his/her struggle is not against flesh in blood—it is not the student or teacher who is making their lives hard--, but against all levels of evil forces set out to trip him/her up and destroy his/her life. When evil comes, help him/her to Stand Their Ground." (Ephesians 6: 10-13) Christ, be their firm foundation. Enable them to stand steadfast and strong. God, I intercede for my child asking that You would place friends around him/her that sharpens their faith like "Iron sharpens iron." (Proverbs 27:17) Give my child at least one friend that is Christlike to walk this faith journey with. I also pray that my child is so close to You that his/her life is controlled and guided by Your Hand. As they go about

their day, "May they hear a voice behind them saying, - This is the way you should go, walk in it; whether to the right or to the left." (Isaiah 30:21) Lord, teach my child that more important than any accolade, making any team, or being selected for any honor- that obedience to You is first and foremost. Let them heed to the Holy Spirit drawing their heart to spend time with You. If my child would but keep his/her eyes focused on You, Oh God, then everything else would fall into place. Lord, journey with them. I cannot be with my child at all times, so I place this dear one in Your Hands. Protect their minds and protect their bodies. Pull them away from the influence of Social Media to the Divine influence of the Most High God.

Prayers for Yourself

God, help me as a Parent to lead well. You tell us in the first chapter of James that, "if anyone lacks wisdom that we can ask of God, and that You will give it to us generously." I need wisdom, Lord. I need Your power within me to direct my every action so take control. Lord, please enable me not only to guide my child, but give me God- given insight on how to strengthen their faith. Let me make the most of moments in the car, time after school, or when we eat to impress God's word on his/her heart. Make me wise when we look at what activities my kid will participate in. Remind me that church and youth group - those things that strengthen a child's faith -have eternal value. Christ must come first. Give me boldness to "pray in the Spirit at all times with all kinds of prayers and requests. Help me to be alert and always be praying." (Ephesians 6:18) Give me a greater vision for my life and for my family's life. Stir the Holy Spirit within me. "I pray that out of His glorious riches, the Lord would strengthen me with power through His Spirit in my inner being so that Christ may dwell in my heart through faith." (Ephesians 3:16-17) Lord, parenting is a calling. Help me fulfill my purpose. I ask You to mold and make me into the parent that my child needs. Help me to set apart time to be in the scriptures and pray so that I am completely in tune with Your will.

Father God, I pray Ephesians 3:20-21 over this year knowing that, "God is able to do immeasurably more that what I ever thought or imagined- in our schools, in my kid's life, and in my heart,- according to the power of Christ that is at work within me--- to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever! I lift this prayer in the Never ceasing, Stronghold breaking, Miracle working, Prodigal returning, and Powerful Name of Jesus Christ, Amen and amen.
