MORNING TIME ON THE PORCH

SERMON SUMMARY

Revelation 10:1-7 – The Mighty Angel with the Little Book

8/26 - Romans 1:16-17 "Not Ashamed of the Gospel of Jesus Christ." Read Romans 1:13-15.

8/27 - None.

8/28 - Revelation 10:5-6 "Warning: Delay No Longer - the Day of the Lord Approaches." Read Revelation 6:9-10 and Revelation 9:20-21.

8/29 - Revelation 10
"Are You Ready?."
Read Mark 13:32-37,
Matthew 24:36-44 and
Luke 21:34-36.

8/30 - Psalm 46:10 "Labor Day Rest." Read Matthew 11:28-30, Hebrews 12:1-2, Colossians 3:1-4, Philippians 4:8 and II Corinthians 3:1-4. Pastor Art continued his sermon series from Revelation with a sermon entitled "The Mighty Angel with the Little Book" based on Revelation 10:1-7. The point of the entire book of Revelation is to point everyone toward salvation. There's only one way to heaven and that's through Jesus. Read John 14:6. This passage reminds us that God will unveil hidden things when we get to heaven. He specifically directs John, the author of Revelation, not to record what the seven thunders had to say. God's timing is perfect. All will be revealed in His time. The Bible stands alone. Taking away or adding to the Bible is not the truth of God's Word. The message from God is turn from sin and repent. Live a life pleasing to Christ. Your life becomes a testimony to God. Get yourself a Bible that you are comfortable with. To study and understand the book of Revelation, you need to know the other books of the Bible.

This passage in the book of Revelation is the midpoint of the tribulation time. Everything prior in Revelation leads up to verse 7 - preparing for the 7th angel to blow the trumpet. All of this is laid out for us so that we understand the absolute importance of salvation. Read I Thessalonians 5:9-11. Pastor Art posed the question - Why is God waiting? Read Romans 3:23 and II Peter 3:9. God is patient. He is waiting for people to come to him. Read Romans 8:38-39. It is our hearts for Christ. We are called to witness. This scripture passage begins with the description of an Archangel sent to earth. The angel brings an important message. The rainbow is a promise. God's promise is always fulfilled. This angel proclaiming the earth to be God's. Seven thunders give voice and John is directed not to record what he has heard. Read

CALL TO WORSHIP

Read Psalm 29:1-4

SPECIAL READING

We were blessed again this week with a special reading from Mr. Terry Ealey. He explained that he writes what God inspires him to record. This week he entitled his work "To Guide Another in Need" and described how God enables him to search for the lost and to walk with them.

John 12:27-33. The angel declares the time for delay is over. Read Revelation 6:10-11. Jumping ahead to Revelation 11:15-16, things get even worse as destruction continues with the blowing of the trumpet. Read I Corinthians 15:50-58.

There are 7 Biblical mysteries that God accomplishes. They are: 1) rapture, 2) Israel's blindness, 3) God's wisdom, 4) Christ in the church, 5) Christ in us, 6) the Kingdom of Heaven, and the mystery of Godliness (Read I Timothy 3:16). All of these have been prophesied and will be fulfilled. The answer is Jesus. The bottom line is that we need to please God rather than those around us. Read I Corinthians 15:52, 58. Praising God for a pastor that speaks the truth and encourages us to study God's Word for answers and guidance.


PRAYING FOR ISRAEL NIGHT AND DAY


THANK YOU, OCC
