Pastor Art returned to our in depth study of the book of Revelation with a sermon entitled "God's Temple & Our Witness," based on Revelation 11:1-5. He stated that God put our tent revival at the perfect time. Our church is spiritually stronger because of that event. Then he went over the scripture passage focusing on how it applies directly to us. You are the temple of the Holy Spirit. How am I witnessing? This scripture passage is powerful as it focuses on the temple and witnessing. Does your past give you a testimony that you can share with others? Of course, it does. God allows you a unique testimony. Ask yourself, how can God use me as well as the Body of Christ to reach others? You are called out of the world set aside to serve God. You are changed because you have been born again.

God will never be without a witness. This passage is here for us to know God's plan. A third temple will be built. He reviewed the history of the temple that replaced the tabernacle. Solomon built the first temple. Zerubbabel built the second temple. It was enhanced by Herod the Great and often called the Herodian Temple. It was destroyed in 70 AD. The temple in this passage is referred to as the Tribulation Temple. It is on the horizon. In addition to the measuring of the Holy of Holies for the temple, there will be a measuring of the people. The building of this temple is in the first half of the tribulation. Read Daniel 9:27, where he describes the abomination of desolation. This

points to the entrance of the Antichrist (a false Christ), who expects others to worship him.

We need to understand that the temple God is measuring is us. Read I Corinthians 6:19 about the power of the Holy Spirit. We are studying what our heart is supposed to look like. Read I Corinthians 6:18 (barriers). Two witnesses are needed because of Mosaic law. Read Mark 6:7-13. Christ sent his apostles out 2 by 2 and empowered them. The two olive trees and two lampstands represent the witnesses. The olive tree represents the Holy Spirit. Read Zechariah 4:2-6. The Holy Spirit never runs out. It is not depleted. You are a light to the world. Do they see Jesus in us? Read Zechariah 4:11.

God will never be without two things. God started the temple with the very first person who gave their heart to Him and He gave them the Holy Spirit. The fire spoken of in this passage represents the Word of God. Are we the temple of God? Are we witnessing for God? Praising God for a pastor who keeps us on the straight and narrow way reminding us of God's call on our lives and his guiding hand!
