Pastor Art has started a mini-series on discipleship. His first sermon in this series was "To Make Disciples We Must First Be Disciples," based on Matthew 28:16-20. As we start a new year, Pastor Art wanted to focus on discipleship. This is one of our missions. The other being John 8:12. Then he stated that being a theologian doesn't trump having a personal relationship with Christ. Living the knowledge that you take in daily is being a disciple. A more formal definition of disciple is being an apprentice or attached to a teacher to learn specifically from that person. Read Isaiah 8:16. Jesus was not the only one to have disciples. Read John 1:35-37. Others recorded in the Bible as having disciples include Isaiah and John the Baptist. By learning from these godly men, the disciples were actually learning and following God. Read John 1:1 and Matthew 28:18. Christ has full authority. We are following God through Christ. Read John 14:6, Revelation 5:12, Philippians 2:10-11 and Revelation 1:7. Everyone will see Christ when he returns. But the Body of Christ will recognize Christ because we are his disciples. Read Revelation 19:15. The wrath of God will come through Christ.

Jesus told his disciples ahead of time where to go and what to do. Read Matthew 26:32. They were told to meet Him in Galilee. As Christ followers we learn what we are to do by studying the gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. Gospel means the truth. In Matthew 28:10. They are commanded to do what Jesus says. So two things happened: 1) They did what Jesus told them to do and 2) they worshipped. So a disciple is a worshipper, a servant, and a witness. Worship is both individual and corporate. Read John chapter 4 about the


ASHES TO BEAUTY WOMEN'S ENCOUNTER WEEKEND

BRIDGE OF HOPE


