SERMON SUMMARY

Revelation 13:1-10 - The Beast From The Sea, Part 2

Pastor Art continued in the thirteenth Chapter of Revelation with a sermon entitled "The Beast From the Sea: Part 2" Revelations 13:1-10. He reviewed last week's message where we learned the Beast had a powerful deceptive appearance. Last week we focused on the first two verses, which were about the attributes of the Beast, specifically his person and his authority.

This week we will focus on the AntiChrist's esteem, worship, vanity, actions and his followers. In verse 3, it starts out talking about all the world (meaning outside of the believers during the tribulation). It is a pictorial description of the AntiChrist's esteem. Pastor Art stated his belief that it was a fake wound that the AntiChrist recovers from but the world believes that he was resurrected from the dead. Read II Thessalonians 2:9. The "lying wonders" described in this passage means not a true miracle. Note that there is unparalleled death in the world during the tribulation. In verse 4, we learned that they worshipped the dragon. This is satanic worship and it will be widespread. When we see the word "worship" in the Bible, it is a reminder to put God first. Does the world see us put God first? Our priorities should be worship, prayer, studying God's Word and reflecting Christ in our life. How am I leading the world to God? I shall serve no other god before the Almighty God.

In verses 5 & 6, we learn that the AntiChrist has been given authority for 42 months. Vanity becomes evident. The AntiChrist will curse God and belittle Him. Wickedness will reign on earth. The AntiChrist will be the mouth of satan. Man has denied God's existence since the fall of the Garden of Eden. We have got to speak the truth. Worshipping satan started a long time ago. During those last 42 months, it will be brutal. In verse 7, the AntiChrist is given a lot of authority. Yet it also reminds us that God is sovereign. The saints will be persecuted. There will be worldwide slaughter of God's

Read Psalm 5:1-3

people. This was predicted by the prophet Daniel. Read Daniel 9:27 and Matthew 24:15. Jesus refers to this as the abomination of desolation. Read II Thessalonians 2:3-4. This persecution will solidify the AntiChrist's power over the world. In verse 8 & 9, it is pointed out that non-believers will worship the AntiChrist.

We are called to live differently from the world. We are watched by the world. Seven times in the Bible, New Testament believers are described as having their names written in the lamb's book of life. Read Revelation 3:5. Jesus promised that he who overcomes will not have his name blotted out. Read Romans 8:38-39 and I Peter 1:18-19. We have been redeemed by the precious blood of Christ. Two takeaways today: first, God never releases his control on the earth because He is sovereign. Second, if you have received salvation, it comes through the blood of Jesus Christ. Praising God for a pastor who always emphasizes God's eternal love and sovereignty.

DEVELOPING KIDS GHANA (DKG) UPDATE

Ni ti yuum palli! Or Happy New Year! In Ghana you greet people with Happy New Year the first time you see them in the new year, even if it is two months after the start of the new year! Jared, Anna, Nathaniel and Abigail left Indianapolis on February 13th and arrived in Tamale the following day. We are all happy to be back and getting back to a normal routine. Before leaving Indiana we shipped 9 barrels with books, educational materials and personal items that would not fit in our suitcases. We hope they will arrive in Ghana later this month. We are excited to announce that DKG has a Scholarship Foundation set up at the Putnam County Foundation in Greencastle, IN. The fund was started with \$100 and our prayer is that it will grow through gifts and Capital so that one day it will support our scholarship fund in Ghana. The first goal is to reach \$12,000, which will allow us to receive an annual interest payment of 4.5%. We know this fund may grow slowly to start out, but we believe it will be a tremendous blessing in the future. One of our big goals is to see how we can make DKG a sustainable organization in the future. We recognize that some day, maybe many

years in the future, God will call us back to the US and when that time comes, we don't want all of our hard work to come to an end. Thank you for giving so generously at the end of 2024, we received around \$23,000 between our personal fund and DKG! DKG currently has \$15,000 given for the school project. We will be starting to clear the ground, as soon as the legal paperwork comes back from the government. Our goal is to raise \$100,000 by June so that we can start the foundation and sub-structure. Living expenses continue to rise here in Ghana and we are living off the same income as when we arrived almost 9 years ago. This year we are able to give ourselves a little raise due to some changes in our sending organization raising the salary level for all global workers.
